

2023 AID Dermatology Nursing Courses Delivered through the Australian Institute of Dermatology

Thank you for your enquiry about the AID Dermatology Nursing Courses. These courses are open to all Nursing graduates in Australia or Overseas. The Courses will commence in Feb 2023 and be available to start when you wish. The courses are divided into 4 streams to better correlate with the varied type of work a candidate does in the different dermatology specialist areas.

Course Hardware Requirements Mac running Leopard operating system or later or PC Computer running Vista or Windows 7 or 8 or 10 with a broadband internet connection, preferably ADSL 2 or a good wireless connection. A digital camera should be purchased such as the Canon Powershot or the Sony Cybershot series which are easy to use and have excellent macros for taking close up images. The Nikon Coolpix range are also good. Modern Phone Cameras are also acceptable with images transferred to your computer.

Course Software and Books You should purchase a copy of Clinical Dermatology by Soutor and Hordinsky Get the 2nd e edition with website access although the book itself is all that is required for the course. You should also have an Image management program such as <u>ACD See</u> This allows you to organize and resize your clinical images.

Course Delivery The course will be delivered completely online using the Institute's website www.aiddermnurseconsult.com You can progress at your own pace with each stream. You should view the video descriptions of each stream at There is an online examination that you complete live when you wish to take it. If you pass the examination you will receive the appropriate stream Certificate of achievement from the Institute. If you fail you will have to re sit the examination at a fee of \$75

Cost of the Dermatology Nursing Courses The courses comprise 4 streams to better match the varying environments where nurse work in the dermatology field.

Stream 1 is General Medical Dermatology for a Dermatologist's rooms

Stream 2 is Skin Cancer Nursing particularly for nurses in a Skin Cancer Clinic

Stream 3 looks at various procedures and treatment modalities carried out by Derm Nurses

Stream 4 looks at Nursing in Cosmetic Clinics

Candidates who pass at least 2 of the 4 courses will have ongoing access for 1 year to the course websites and the virtual clinical meeting site. They will also be eligible to attend the Membership Alumni webinars. These are held every two weeks during the teaching semesters. Candidates can also submit interesting cases they have seen or need help diagnosing or managing to the course Virtual Clinical Meeting site.
